Alice's Cook Book: recipe 3

Fall has arrived and all the flowers are going to seed. To many individuals this is the time of year that many delicacies can be prepared and stored for the following seasons. This week's recipe is to a rather dangerous concoction. The danger arises when not used in conscientiously applied program. When taking this goodie please consult a travel agent and arrange for a guide. But, enough with the chatter. Today's recipe is a simple morning glory seed extraction. To obtain the best results get some fresh seeds from a vine. Be careful of packaged seeds as they usually are poisoned with a preservative.

Grind up 100 grams of fresh seeds and place in a one pint jar.
 Add 120 millilitres of Technicalgrade petroleum ether and let stand two

days with occasional shaking.
 Filter and keep the solid portion, discard the liquid.
 Add 100 milliliters of over 100 proof vodka; again let stand for two days

with occasional stirring.
 Filter and save both portions. To the solid portion add another 100 milliliters of vodka and let stand two days. Filter and discard the seed mush and combine the two liquid portions.
 Allow the liquid to evaporate in a large dish, this may take over a day. This will leave a yellow residue.
 Dissolve the residue in 75 milliliters of water.
 The water solution makes three passes. If one doesn't kill you the other will.
